- Developed by Bawinanga Aboriginal Corporation in 2018
- Mixes Traditional Knowledge with social enterprise
- Natural resource-based enterprises focusing on Bushfoods and Seafoods



Bushfoods

- Established in 2017 with Leila Nimbadja
- Started with Man-morlak (Kakadu Plum)
- Now 10 different products plus many experimental
- Large harvests of Djarduk and Man-morlak benefit about 150 harvesters
- Value adding spice mix
- Loved by chefs around Australia



Seafood

- Operating since 2016 Vision of Don, Jimmy, Stuart
- Aboriginal Coastal Licenses net and line fishing
- Mud Crabs
- Barramundi (currently leasing license)
- Aquarium Species
- Quality and affordable protein for the community
- Support from NT Government, NT Fisheries, CDP
