
Story line

Tale of two scales






Scale: objectives, timing, mitigation options













Players: responsibilities, neighbours












Risks can change

- Reinforces role of planning
- Requirement for Regional Bushfire Management Plans
- Declared Bushfire Management Areas temporary in response to unusual risk
- Property plans


